Recently, our offices received a letter from the Westford town manager detailing an incident that occurred on February 20, 2014 involving a Pan Am Railways (Pan Am) train derailment at the Bridge Street overpass.


The letter identifies the town's concern over the public safety risks associated with a train derailment (particularly in that area) and notification issues to the town during and after incidents such as this. The letter also details ongoing difficulty the town has had in its attempts to discuss other issues with Pan Am involving public safety, health and environmental concerns.

We respectfully request a meeting at your earliest convenience with representatives from Pan Am, Westford officials, and Westford's legislative and Congressional delegations to discuss these concerns.
